It is designed by Margrethe Odgaard. 'The idea was to create a both honest and environmentally friendly – textile with a poetic feel by recycling leftover material from Kvadrat's own production, explains Margrethe Odgaard. Reminiscent of colorful stitchings on a darker background, Re-wool features exceptional depth of color, creating a dynamic play on the textile's surface when applied to furniture.

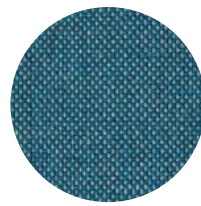

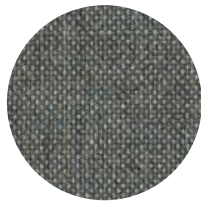

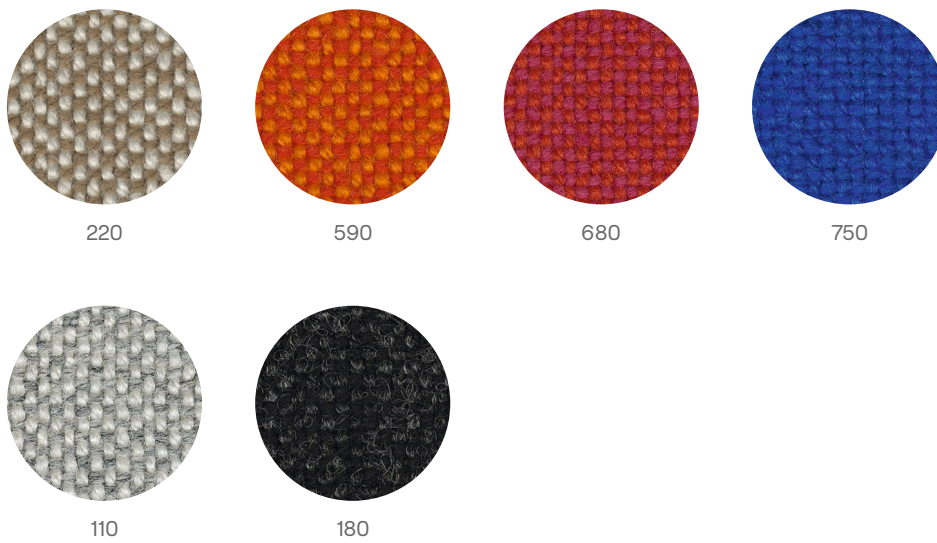

Kvadrat's first textile Hallingdal has become the archetype of woollen textiles. The very durable upholstery fabric was originally designed in 1965 by Nanna Ditzel, and is now available in a version with an updated color scale. Hallingdal is made of wool and viscose, which complement each other: the wool provides excellent durability and flexibility, whilst the viscose adds brilliance and depth to the color. Both materials are dyed before they are spun, which highlights the rich texture of the fabric.
